The FRR supports the CDP Water Disclosure Project

Paris, October 12th, 2010- As an extension of the support it has brought to the CDP (Carbon Disclosure Project) for the past four years, the FRR is pleased to announce its support for the CDP Water Disclosure Project. A long-term investor such as the FRR cannot afford to overlook water-related issues. Indeed, water is a scarce resource whose management will become a major economic, social and political challenge against the backdrop of climate change, population growth and rapid urban development.

The Water Disclosure Project is based on the same principle as the Carbon Disclosure Project, which, since 2000, has been encouraging businesses around the world to publish their carbon emission statistics. Within the context of the Water Disclosure Project, a questionnaire has been sent out to the world's 300 largest corporations that are active in the sectors that use the most water or that are the most exposed to water-related risks. The findings are expected in November 2010.

The information gathered will be used to give investors a better idea of corporate practice in the area of water management, use and recycling and help them assess the regulatory or physical risks to which they are exposed.
